COOKS CORNER

HOT CRAB DIP

- One 8 OZ. pck. Cream Cheese
- One can (6 - 8 oz.) crab meat, drained & flaked
- Two Tablespoons milk
- One Tablespoon minced onion
- One Tablespoon lemon juice
- One Tablespoon sherry wine (optional)
- One & half teaspoons grated lemon rind
- One teaspoon horse radish
- Warm cream cheese in 1-qt. casserole in microwave
- 1-2 min. Stir in all remaining ingredients. Cover with plastic wrap and return to microwave. Heat several minutes. Stir before serving.
